Steingraeber-Hoftheater, two performances at the Bayreuth Studio Stage, each at 8 pm: **Lohengrin sein Vater und der Gral** by **Uwe Hoppe**, freely adapted from Richard Wagners' original. Premiere on July 20, further dates July 27 / 30 – August 13, 17, 18, 20, 22, 24. Director Agatha Ruppert has been invited to stage Wagner's "Lohengrin". She plans to intersperse video projections. These scenes will be rehearsed and recorded in a "Bluebox". The "Parsifal" plot is thus created in a montage of "Lohengrin" passages. The second production starts on 3 August with further dates: August 4, 7, 9, 10 **Leubald** by **Richard Wagner** redacted by **Uwe Hoppe. Leubald** is the first work of the pubescent Richard which he wrote at the age of just 14 - some characters from his later operas are already sketched out and come to life with their leitmotifs: **live piano** by Hans Martin Gräbner.

Wagner Introductions on the Liszt Grand Piano

Rococo Hall in the Steingraeber House on all performance days 11 - approx. 12 h: In his entertaining introductions to the works, pianist **Hans Martin Gräbner** provides an overview over the plot and key musical passages on the grand piano. His focus is on the work itself, which he introduces in an informative and charming way using many sound examples (some of which are sung).
