#### Franz Liszt In the Photography of His Time

- The former collection of the pianist Ernst Burger is now part of the piano museum in the Steingraeber Haus. The largest collection of original historical photographs of Franz Liszt is divided into nine periods of his life - from 1843 to 1886 - free admission as part of Hans Martin Gräbner's introductions to his works and before the guided tours of the piano museum and the piano manufactory.
